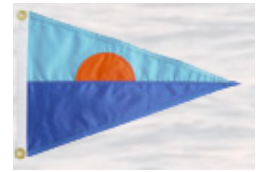

AHOY Club Members and Guests,

This is an update to previous cruise material and provides our best current information. Further updates will follow. Thanks for your patience and understanding.

Understandably some of the port hosts remain a bit uncertain on all details as governmental regulations change. The club policy will be to follow the Maine requirements in place on the dates of the cruise.

Individual captains are responsible for obtaining their dockage or moorings at the various ports or as noted. See individual port contacts below.

A general summary of itinerary follows: Also see "Cruising Guide to the Maine Coast" by Tafts and Rindlaub for more information. Where times are not shown they will be provided later.

JULY 10 PRE-CRUISE MEETING AT LUKE'S BOATYARD.

Cruise packets will be distributed and final cruise details reviewed. Governmental social distancing and maximum numbers will be the club policy. Woody Wagon provided, each boat brings appetizer.

JULY 11 TENANTS HARBOR (dockage/moorings) / LONG COVE (anchoring).

Hoping to have a gathering on shore with all boats providing appetizers and BYOB. Dinner on your own. Fuel available. Dinghy ride of about 1.2 mile from Long Cove to Tenants town dock.

JULY 12 CAMDEN (dockage, floating docks, moorings).

Scavenger on your own in town on arrival. Drinks and lobster bake at Rhumb Line at Wayfarer Marine. Lobster Bake \$45 (payable at pre-cruise meeting) – 16:00-18:00. Cocktails before at 15:00 Fuel available. Pump out boat available.

JULY 13 STOCKTON SPRINGS (dockage, moorings, anchoring).

JULY 16 BURNT COAT HARBOR (anchoring/moorings). Note: Frenchboro cancelled.  
Fuel available. Dinghy raft-up, wine provided; all boats bring appetizers.

JULY 17 NORTHEAST HARBOR (dockage/floating docks/moorings).
