



The 2022 DEYC Mini Cruise • By Land and By Sea

2022 DEYC Mini Cruise Ports of Call and Planned Events. There is a land-based event planned for each evening. All members are welcomed to join in the fun. A sign-up sheet for Dolphin seating and Iris Eats gathering at Great Island Boat Yard to follow.

11 August: Stover Cove/Harpswell Harbor, West Harpswell

Distance: 25nm

Anchor/Rafting, some Moorings if you know someone.

On our first day we will gather at Stover cove, a very pleasant harbor with excellent protection from the south. Anchor in 25' of water at high tide. Holding is perfect. Shore access is only by dingy at public rocky beach.

Event: Starts at (16:30) 4:30pm Take dingy across (1nm) to Cook's Lobster and Ale House, 68 Garrison Cove Road, Bailey Island. Cook's will hold the appropriate number of tables for the group. Individuals order and pay off the regular menu.

Remember your name tags

FYI: There is a bakery, the Salt Cod Café on Orrs Island. Open Thursday and Friday 8:00am to 3:00 pm. Visit www.saltcodcafe.com for full menu. Another dingy ride for sugary goodness to accompany your morning coffee.

12 August: Dolphin Marina and Restaurant 515 Basin Point, Harpswell

Distance: Hop-Skip-Jump, 4nm or 7.7nm

Moorings / Dock / Anchorage

The next day, enjoy a short run from Stover Cove to Dolphin Marina. Easterly approach travelling through the Pott's Point channel or go out and around Eagle Island for a more leisurely ride.

If you have not already, make reservations.

All boat reservations must be made through Dockwa. Go to www.dockwa.com to reserve. The steps are very easy and if you have been there before, the Dockwa form will likely already have your data posted in. The docking choice has only 2 options "mooring" or "dock". If you prefer a floating dock, select dock and then leave a note in the "Comments" section as to your preference for a floating dock or slip. They will adjust your rate for the floating dock as appropriate after arrival. Excellent launch service is available (plus coffee and blueberry muffins by launch in the morning!). Check in only after noon (1-2pm preferable).

Event: There will be two to three seatings of ten. Group 1 of up to ten will be seated at 5:00pm, Group 2 of up to 10 will be seated at 5:30pm and Group 3 of up to 10 will be seated at 6:00pm A sign-up sheet with a time preference will be forth coming. The Dolphin will hold seating only for the names forward to them by Commodore Jeanne Koenig. Plan to have some light appetizers to share while your group waits their turn. The Dolphin is a club favorite and the service is slow.

13 August: Great Island Boat Yard 419 Harpswell Islands Road

Distance: 12nm

Moorings / Dock / Anchorage: Snow Island North

Our third and last night is at Great Island Boat Yard. All boat reservations must be made through Dockwa. Go to www.dockwa.com to reserve. Or, anchor in the anchorage North of Snow Island. A gathering around 4:30pm is planned at Iris Eats, 419 Harpswell Islands Road, Harpswell, building adjacent to the Boat Yard. Elyse Dana is Chef/Owner and daughter to Michael and Janet Dana of Third Reef.

A charcuterie table is being planned as a fun way to gather on the deck to decompress from a day on the water. Captain's Choice Dinner aboard your boat.
