Thursday, August 16 – Bittersweet Marina/South Bristol

The fleet will meet near South Bristol Thursday at moorings and docks of Bittersweet Marina – anchoring west of Witch Island possible on the mainland and side of the channel. (underwater cables on Witch Island side of channel).

You can visit the Audubon Camp in Muscongus Sound.

Event: Cocktails on dock. BYOB and an appetizer to share on the docks.

Menu: Light meal provided by Osiers Wharf. Menu to follow.

Cost: Based on your meal selection.

Time: 5:00 PM

Directions by Land: Route 1 North to Newcastle/Damariscotta exit. Stay on Business Rt. 1 through Damariscotta and turn right on Route 129/130. Go 2.7 miles to 129/130 junction and bear right on 129 to S. Bristol. Go 9.7 miles and turn left on Thompson Inn Road (a quarter mile before S. Bristol Bridge). Go 500' and turn right at Five Hill Road mailbox to Shed Facility and park at woodpiles. Walk around end of building to docks.

By Sea: From Boothbay Harbor travel east to past Liniken Neck and Thrumcap Island and head north in Johns Bay. Go to port at Witch Island. Contact Mike at Bittersweet Landing Boatyard for dockage and moorings. (Marina # 207-644-8731)

Friday, August 17 – Round Pond

The fleet will move to Round Pond Harbor. There will be some moorings available from Padebco, no reservations can be made. Rafting and anchoring in settled weather will be necessary. The Masters have two moorings and there is a guest mooring if available.

Event: Cocktails on deck at Round Pond Lobster. BYOB and appetizer to share.

Menu: Order off menu at Round Pond Lobster

Cost: Based on meal section

Time: 5:00 PM

Directions by Land: Take Route 1 North through Wiscasset to Route 32 South in Waldoboro. Take Route 32 South to Round Pond Village. Take a left at the Inn at Round Pond into the village and make your first right onto Landing Road Muscongus Bay Lobster Company is at the end of the road, on the pier. Contact Leon or Sarah at Padebco (Marina # 207-529-5106)

Directions by Sea: From Pemaquid Point head north in Muscongus Sound to the entrance to Round Pond Harbor.

Saturday August 18 – Greenland Cove – Home of Allan and Joyce Ivester

Event: Pot Luck Dinner on the grounds, BYOB

Time: 3:00 PM

Possibly activity on own: Visit Audubon Camp on northeast end of Hog Island approximately 1 mile from anchorage by dinghy. Tie up at docks or beach dinghy. Visit facility and explore.

The fleet will move to Greenland Cove where anchoring and rating will be necessary. Please bring a side dish, salad or casserole to share. (If you have an oven on your boat or are coming by land, it would be helpful if you could bring a casserole). Bring your own beverage. The club will provide plates, silverware, napkins and dessert. Bring your own chairs

Directions by Land: Route 1 North to Newcastle/Damariscotta exit. Stay on business Rt. 1 through Damariscotta to McDonald's Take a right onto Biscay Road – after approx.. 5.1 miles. Take a left onto Rt. 32 at the "T" intersection. After 1.4 miles, take a right onto Keene Neck Rd. and follow for 1.1 miles take a right onto Spruce Point Rd (gravel). A ¼ mile on Spruce Point Rd there is a sharp left turn and 100 yards beyond is a large tan boathouse at the head of the driveway, please park there. (Phone is 207-529-5830)

Directions by Sea: North from Round Pond Harbor approximately 3 miles north of Round Pond Harbor past Ram Island into Greenland Cove.
